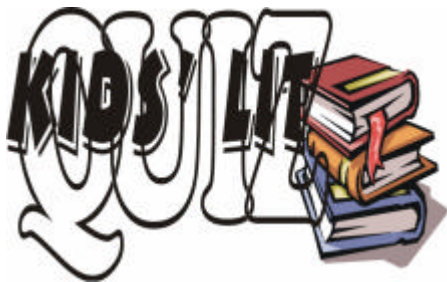


## WELCOME
