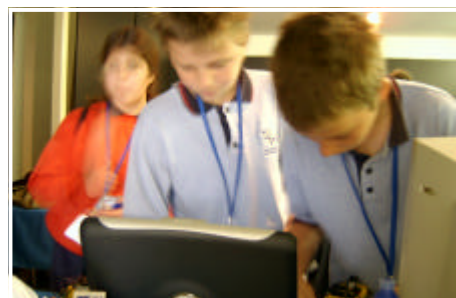
All teams did extremely well in this very demanding competition! To prepare and enter the National Finals is a feat in itself!

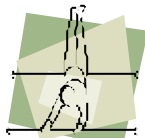

### WESTERN SPRINGS COLLEGE ENROLMENT ISSUE

Children at Pasadena Intermediate who live in the suburbs of Kingsland and Western Springs have lost the right to enrol at Western Springs College. Some parents are getting together to change that.

The College's new enrolment scheme excludes Kingsland and Western Springs from its "home zone". From next year, our children in these suburbs will have to take their chance in a ballot for any out-of-zone places left after children in the "home zone" have enrolled.

The Ministry of Education decided the zone should stop at the North Western Motorway despite the many community links between the College and Kingsland/Western Springs.

However, if enough parents in this area are concerned, the College Board and principal are willing to seek a Ministry review of the zone.

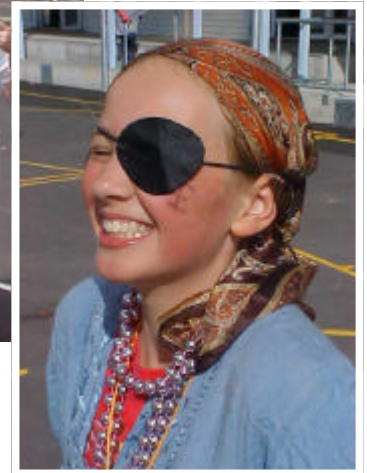
