FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who do we advise if my child tests positive for Covid-19?

- Please contact the School Office as soon as possible
- Email a copy of your positive result to office@pasadena.school.nz

My child has tested positive for Covid-19. What does this mean?

- Your child & household contacts need to isolate for 10 days
- Once your child tests positive, no further testing is required
- Your child can return to school after a 10 days of isolating with no symptoms

My child lives with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19. What does this mean?

- Your child is a household contact (along with all other members of the household) and will need to isolate for 10 days
- Testing happens on Day 3 and Day 10
- If they develop symptoms, get a test sooner
- Your child can return to school after a negative Day 10 test

My child is a close contact of someone who doesn't live with us. Can they come to school?

- Yes, your child **can** come to school
- Anyone who is a close contact of a non-household member does not need to isolate
- Watch for symptoms. Self-isolate and get tested should symptoms develop

My child is isolating. What support will school provide around teaching and learning?

- Learning activities are available on Google Classroom
- Teachers will regularly check in on student's wellbeing via Google Meet
- If your child is unwell, there is no expectation that they will complete activities
